DMCC and Sustainability

DMCC was the first free zone in the UAE to commit to the UN Global Compact and currently houses the largest number of community members committed to sustainability principles.

In line with the UAE's commitment to net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, DMCC's Board of Directors committed to achieve carbon neutrality in DMCC's own operations by 2050. By committing to this target, DMCC is playing its part in mitigating the impact of climate change and creating positive change across the value chain.

In 2023, DMCC initiated a comprehensive organisation-wide carbon footprint assessment in line with the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol, which concluded in March 2024. This six-month project enabled DMCC to identify all Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions, covering the entirety of our operations. Following the baseline calculation, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Steering Committee adopted a decarbonisation strategy along with company-specific KPIs.

Recognising that 84% of DMCC's emissions originate from Scope 3 Category 2, primarily due to our building sector activities, we have incorporated best-in-class sustainable building practices in the construction of our Uptown Tower headquarters. Notably, we installed a 540 kWp solar panel system – the largest ever recorded for use on a construction site – which significantly enhanced energy efficiency and environmental management. Consequently, Uptown Tower achieved LEED Gold certification

Quick Facts and Stats

- DMCC has implemented a 6.3 MW solar parking shade project, the largest in the UAE, that saves over 7,612 MWh annually and reduces energy costs for landlords and tenants.
- DMCC adheres to Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) and United Nations Global Compact standards to foster a responsible business ecosystem.
- DMCC requires that all suppliers undergo environmental screening to ensure sustainable sourcing and ethical business practices.
- DMCC regularly engages with stakeholders to promote and implement best practices in environmental sustainability.
