Introduction

All DMCC Licenced company holding service licence that have one or more of the eligible service activities can apply for NOC to operate onshore subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.

Service to Select on Portal

Company Services – Apply for NOC to operate onshore

Important Notes

- Only DMCC Licenced companies holding service licence type that have one or more of the [eligible service activities](#) can apply for NOC to operate onshore subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.
- Company cannot apply for NOC to operate onshore if:
 - There is an active sanction on their account.
 - They already have an open SR for activity amendment.
 - They already have an open SR for licence termination.
 - They already have an open SR for company termination.
- The NOC will be issued within 2 working days and it will be valid for 90 days from the date of issuance.
- Once the NOC to operate onshore is issued, service fee is not refundable.

Steps

Step 1: Complete the application form to apply for 'Apply for NOC to operate onshore' on the DMCC portal.

Step 2: Proceed with the payment and submit the SR

Step 3: Download the generated NOC on the SR's Documents/ Uploads section.

Step 4: Company will need to approach DED with the provided NOC from DMCC and complete the Department of Economic Development (DED) requirements for obtaining the permit to operate onshore.

Output

- NOC to operate onshore issued
