On this occasion, **Mahmoud Hesham El Burai, Chairman to the United Nations Global Compact Local Network UAE**, said: "The UAE Government has established itself as a role model for the advancement of women in society. At the UAE Local Network, we are proud to contribute to

advancing 'Global Goal 5: Gender Equality' of the Sustainable Development Goals through the Women Empowerment Principles. We are delighted that DMCC made a commitment to the ten universally accepted principles under the United Nations Global Compact and is further advancing their commitment by signing the Women Empowerment Principles."

During the meeting, Iris Van der Veken, Director - International Public Affairs, DMCC accepted an invitation to join the UAE WEP Taskforce and help drive the agenda within DMCC and across the country as a whole.

This is the second global initiative that DMCC commits to over a period of ten months. In August 2017, DMCC was the first Free Zone in the UAE to sign up to the UN Global Compact, the world's largest corporate sustainability initiative.
