To encourage participation, DFC has installed "City in a Gym", a virtual fitness pole in the JLT Park where participants can scan a QR code to access a multitude of workouts activities and more at any time.

Launched in 2017 by His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai and Chairman of the Executive Council, DFC aims to unify the emirate through a month of inclusive fitness activities, with the common goal of leading healthy and active lifestyles.

"His Highness Sheikh Hamdan's Dubai Fitness Challenge is an important initiative that promotes the wellbeing of everyone living in the emirate and one that helps cultivate a healthy and fitness-focussed mindset.
