

Dubai Design Academy to Host first-of-its-kind Jewellery Making and Design Workshops at Jewellery Arabia 2022 in Bahrain

Dubai Design Academy (DDA), which provides accredited professional jewellery making and design courses from its base in the Dubai Multi Commodities Centre (DMCC), will host three dedicated workshops at Jewellery Arabia 2022, the Middle East's premier jewellery and watch event.
